

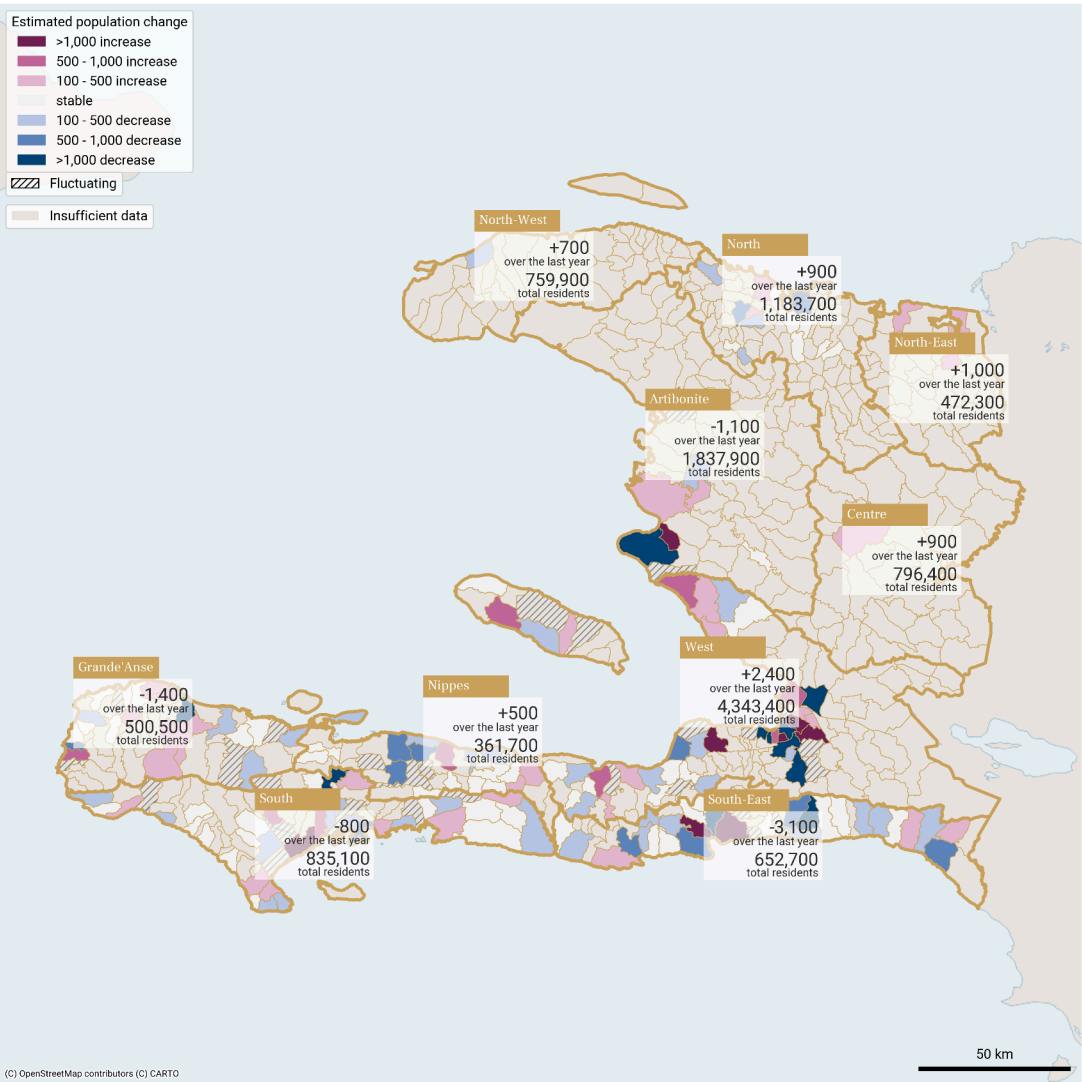

Key observations for the period 01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26

- **NOTE:** The Flowminder-Digicel pipeline was interrupted from June to October 2025, with no data currently available for that period.
- **NOTE:** Damage to fiber optic infrastructure along RN-2 on 24 June and 15 July affected service availability in Haiti's Southern Region, reducing the number of sections in Grande'Anse, Nippes, Sud and Sud-Est with available data in July.
- **NOTE:** Due to partial and low population coverage of the data used by Flowminder, the estimates shown in this report may contain biases. Particularly for the departments Artibonite, Centre and North-East and North-West, data is available only for a small number of sections.
- In the Port-au-Prince Metropolitan Area (ZMPAP), the population continued to increase between November 2025 and July 2026 in 5e Section Bellevue Chardonniere (Pétion-Ville) (+2,440). Between June and July 2026, the estimated population increased in 2e Section Morne l'Hôpital (Port-au-Prince) and 1re Section Turgeau (Port-au-Prince).
- In West outside ZMPAP, the largest population decrease was in 3e Section Sourcailles (Kenscoff) (-2,140), potentially due to arm attacks (ETI100.1).
- In South, the estimated population of 1re Section Bourdet (Les Cayes) increased further from June to July, reaching +2,650, while the estimated population of 5e Section Laroque (Cavaillon) decreased further from June to July (-1,650).
- In South East, the estimated population has declined by 3,100 since November 2025, with the largest continuing decrease in 4e Section Fond Jean Noël (Marigot) (-1,220). The estimated population 6e Section Montagne La Voûte (Jacmel) fell by -1,680 from November 2025 to July 2026. The population continued increasing in 10e Section La Vanneau (Jacmel) (+2,670), while the estimated population in 1re Section Bas Cap Rouge (Jacmel) remained stable between June and July 2026 .

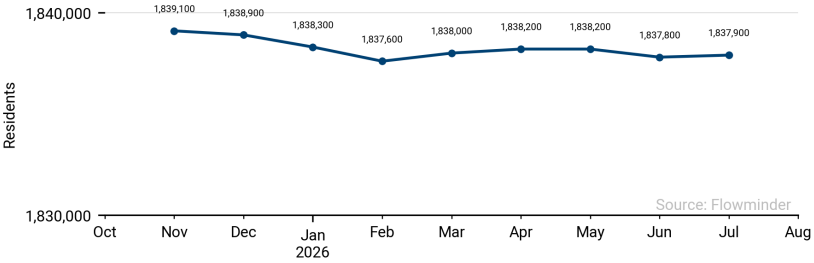
Cumulative estimated population change by departments and communal sections between 1 Nov 2025 and 31 Jul 2026

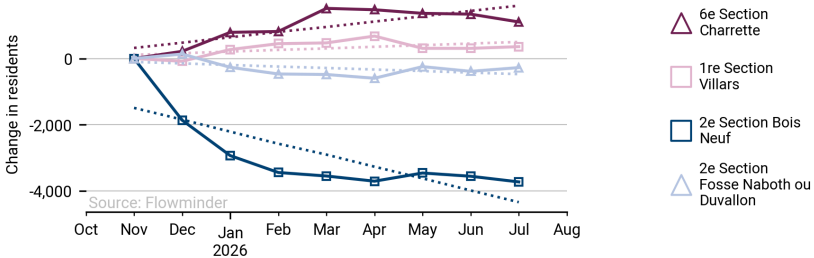
Monthly estimated population in Artibonite (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

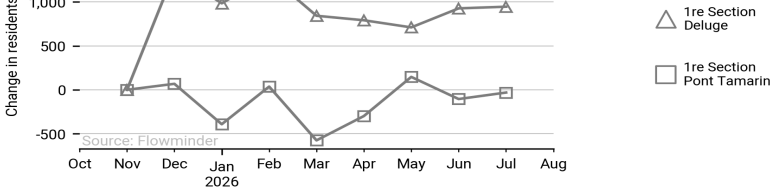


Communal sections in Artibonite with largest estimated change in population (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

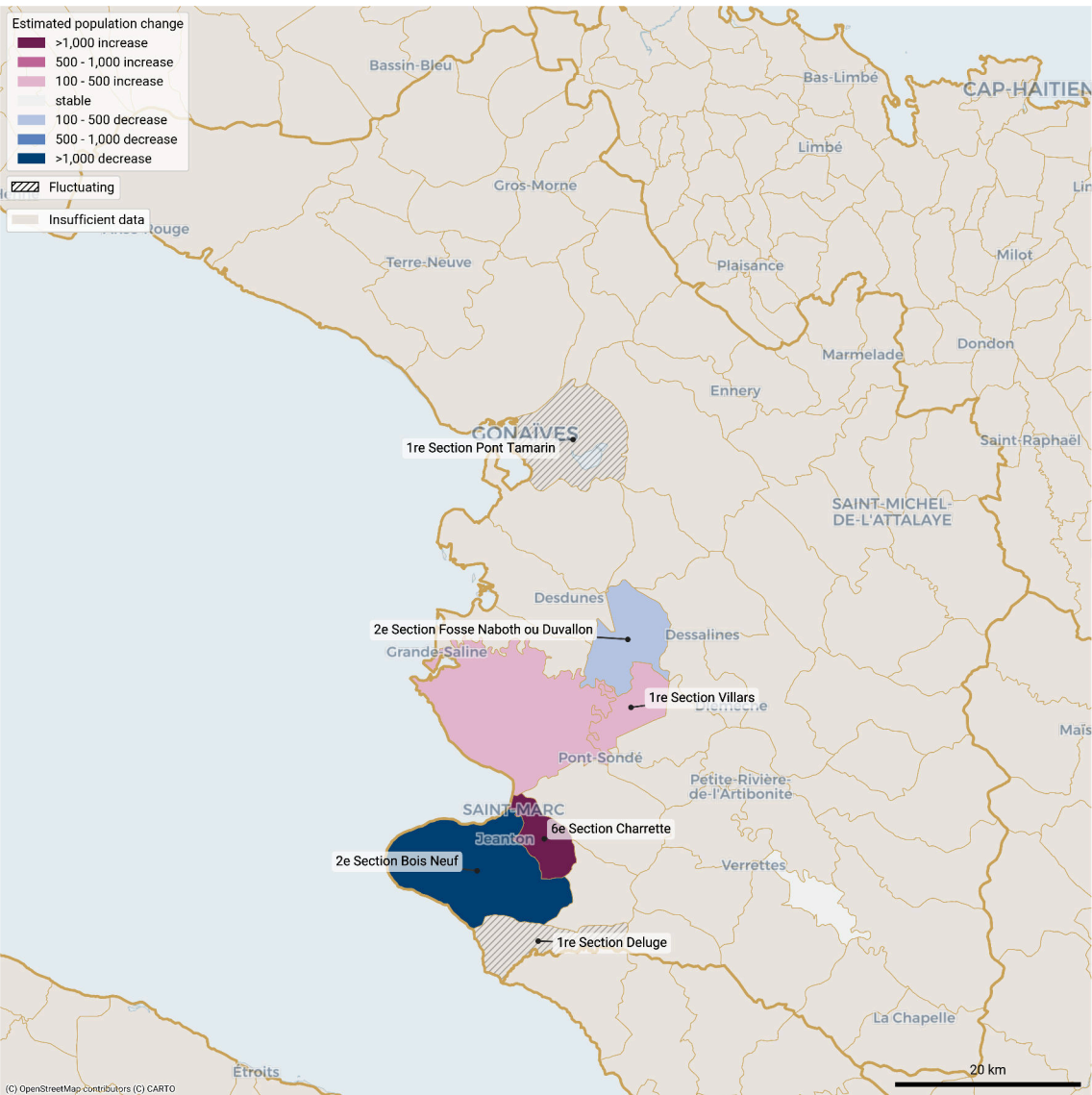
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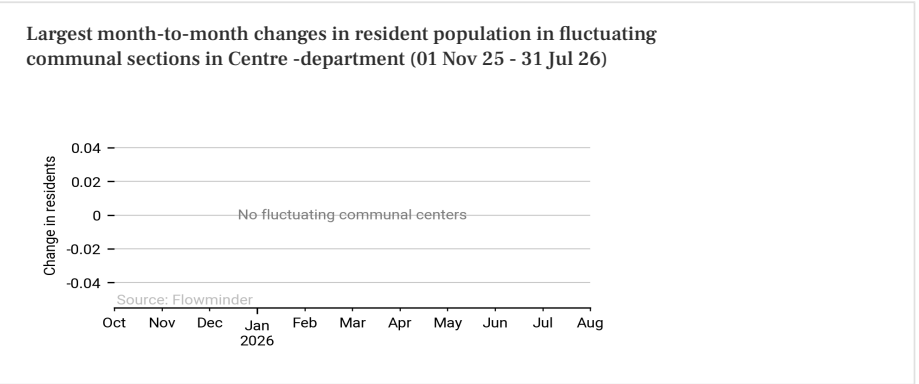
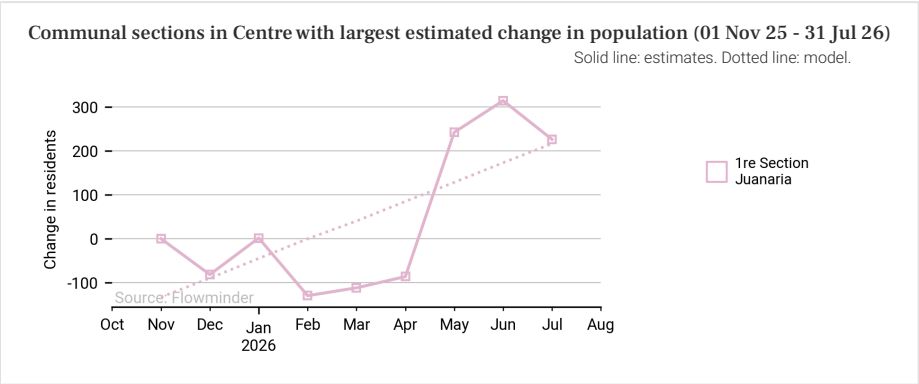
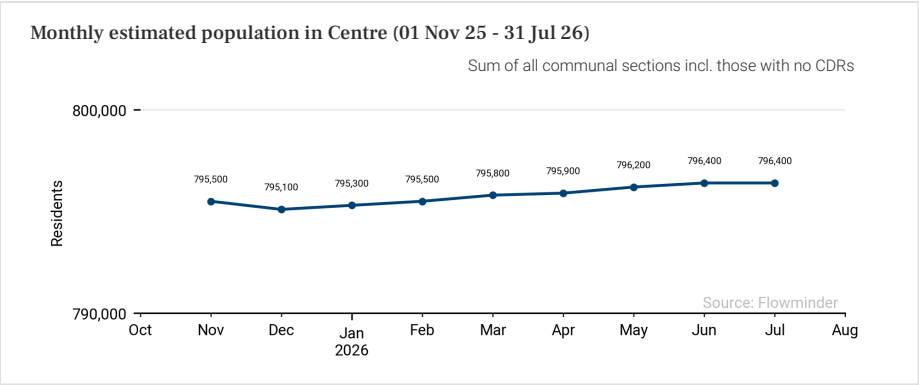
Largest month-to-month changes in resident population in fluctuating communal sections in Artibonite -department (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)



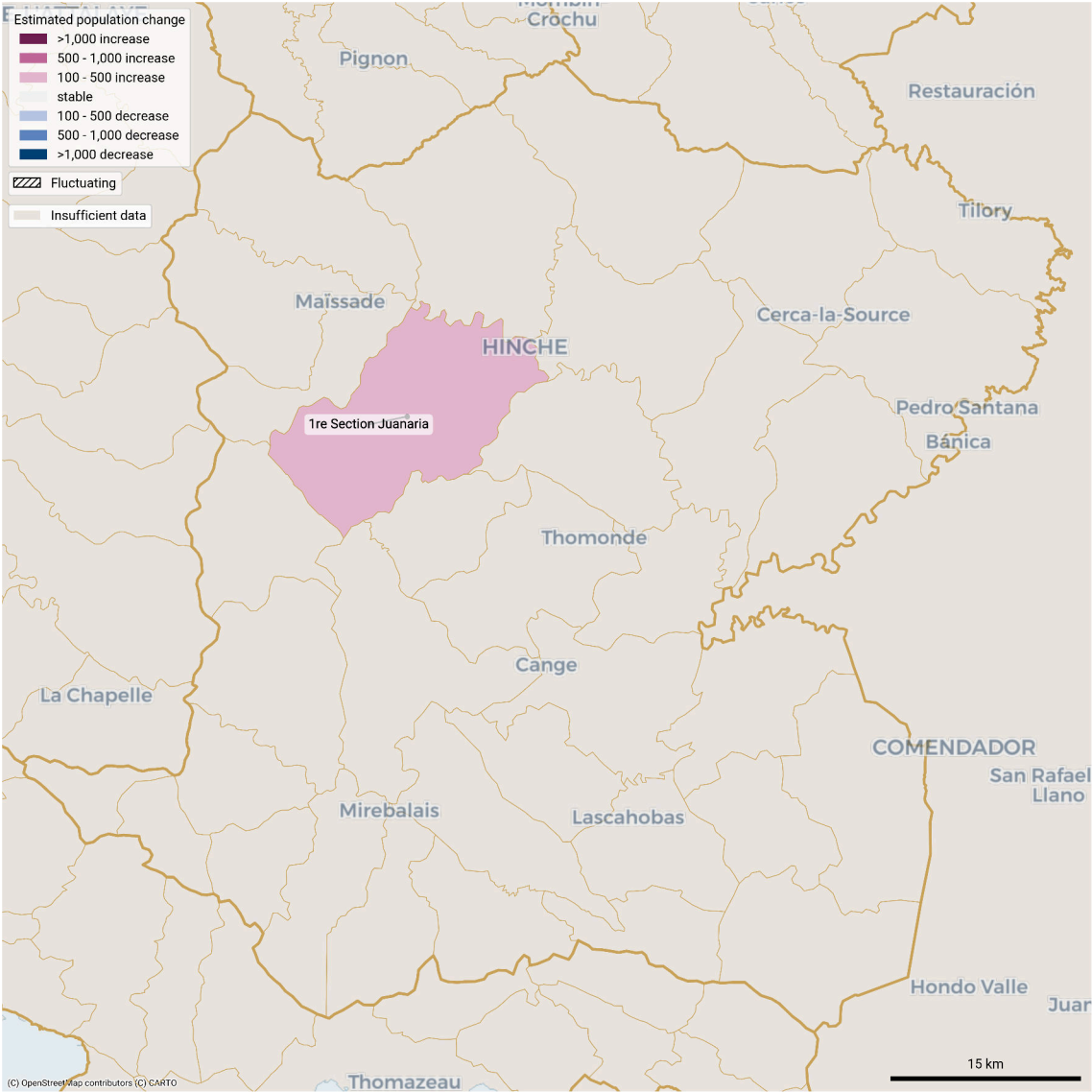
Cumulative estimated population change per communal section in Artibonite from 1 Nov 2025 to 31 Jul 2026



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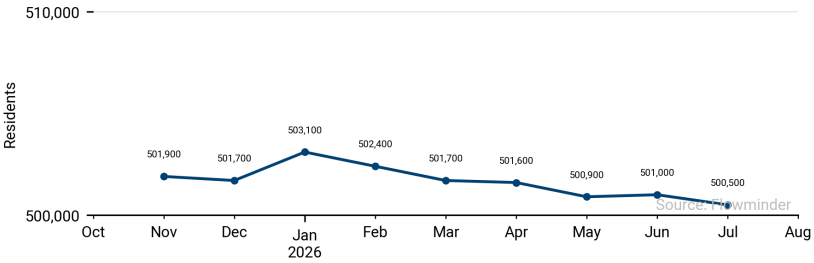
Cumulative estimated population change per communal section in Centre from 1 Nov 2025 to 31 Jul 2026



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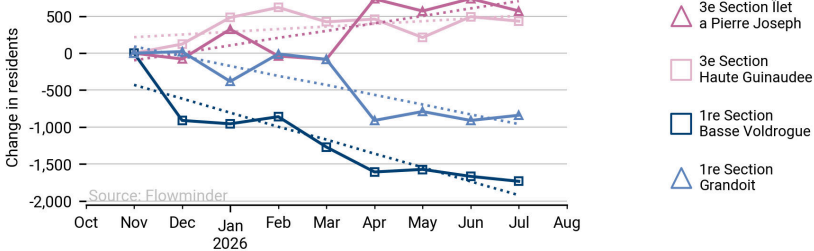
Monthly estimated population in Grande'Anse (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

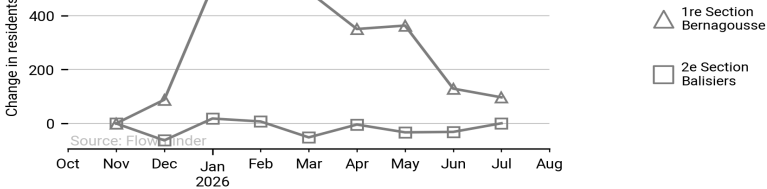


Communal sections in Grande'Anse with largest estimated change in population (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

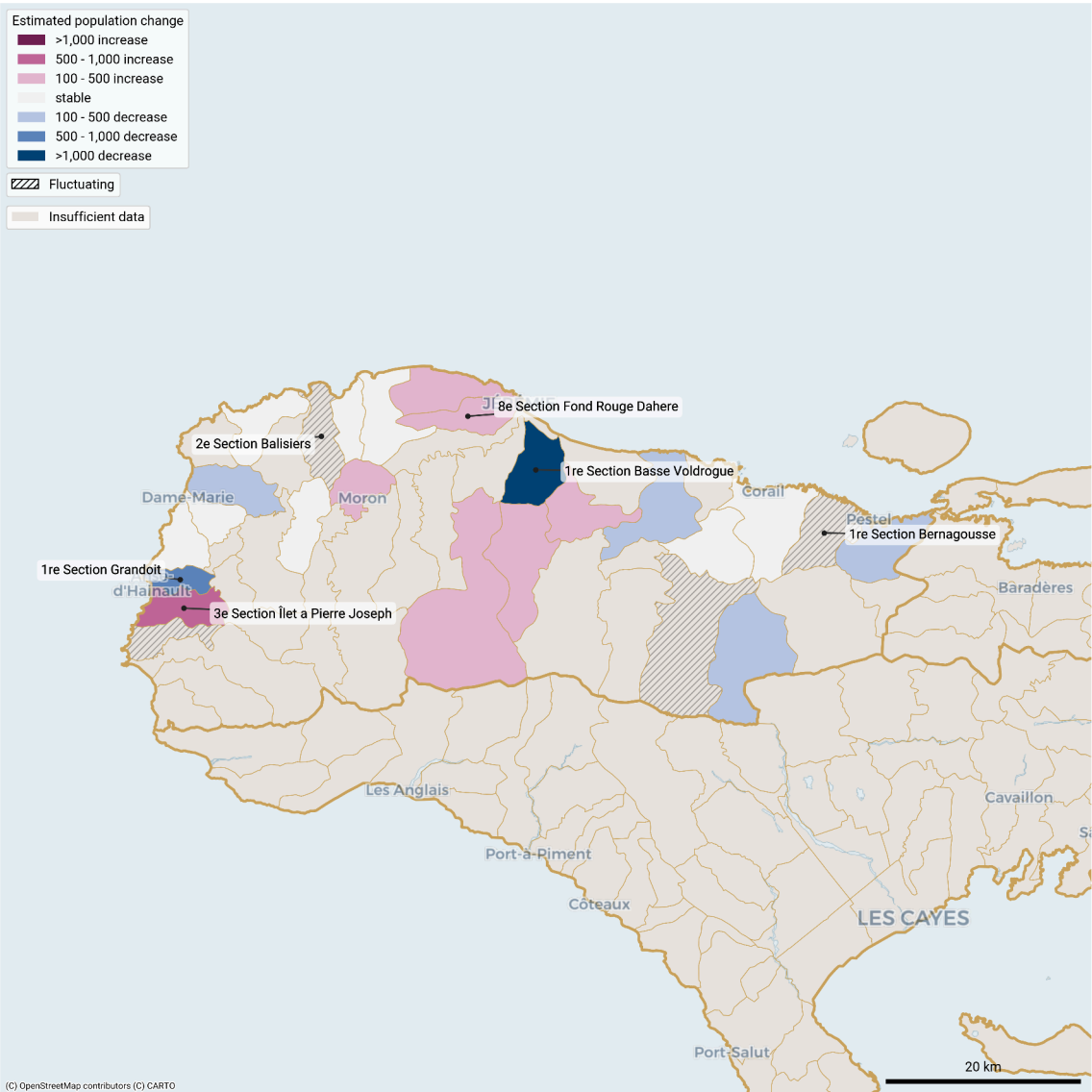

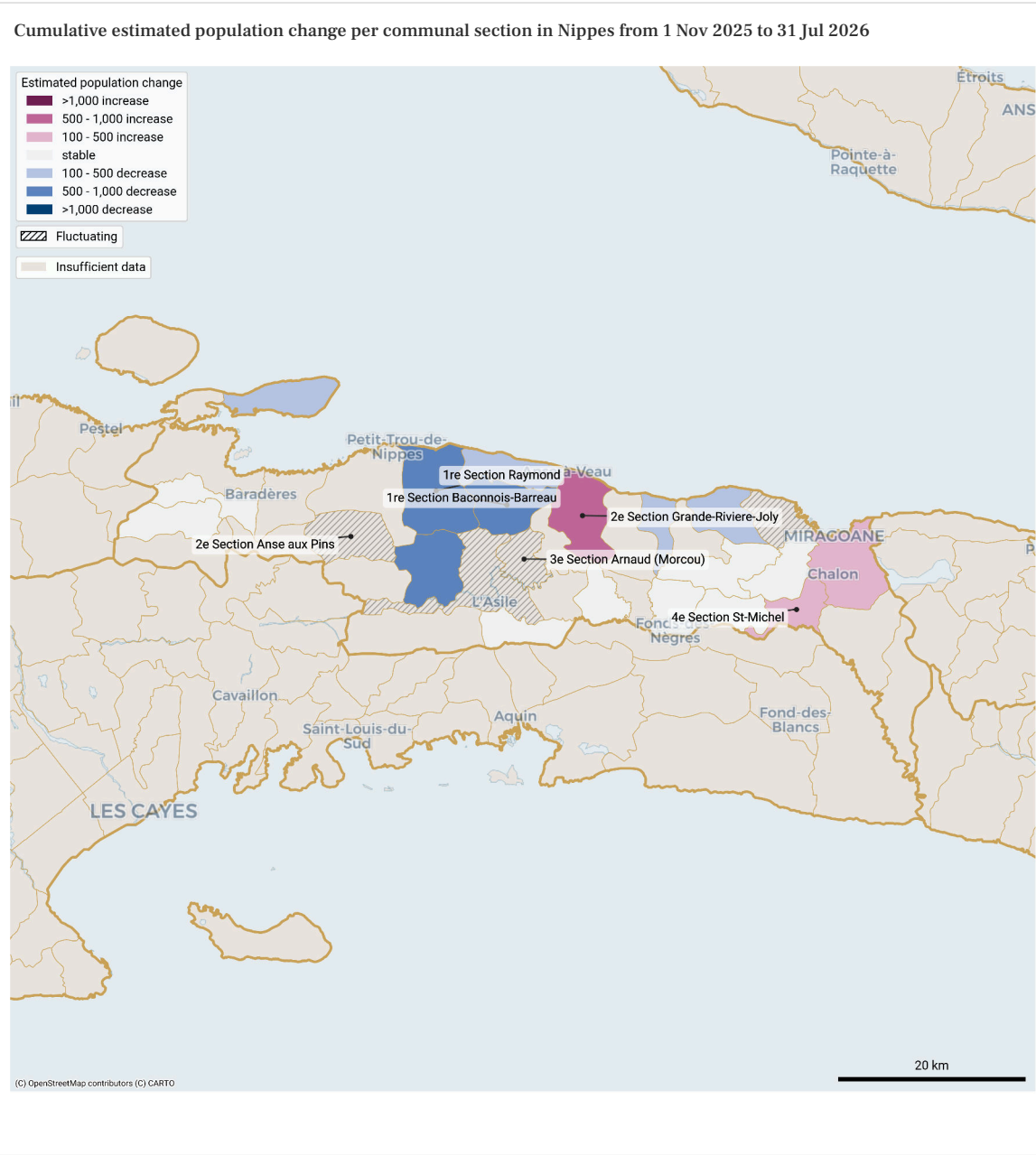
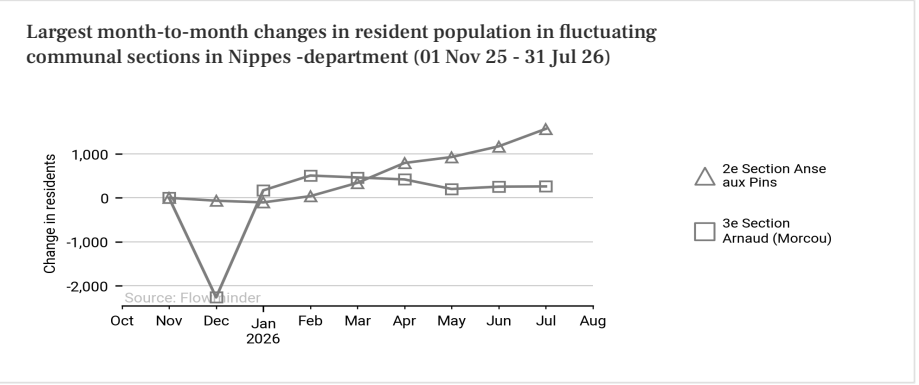
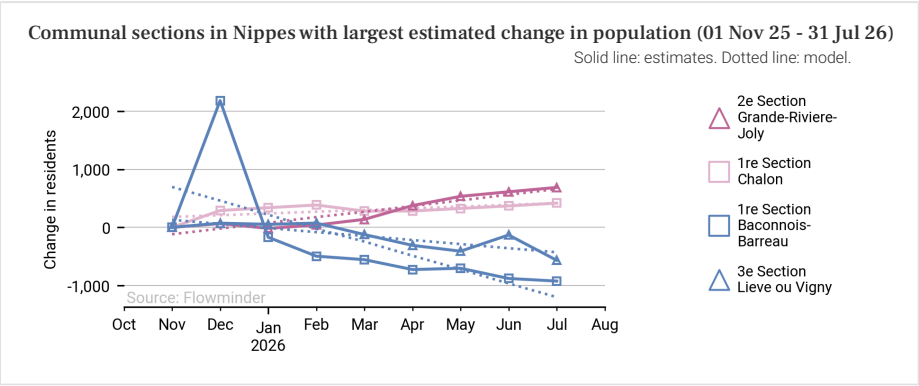
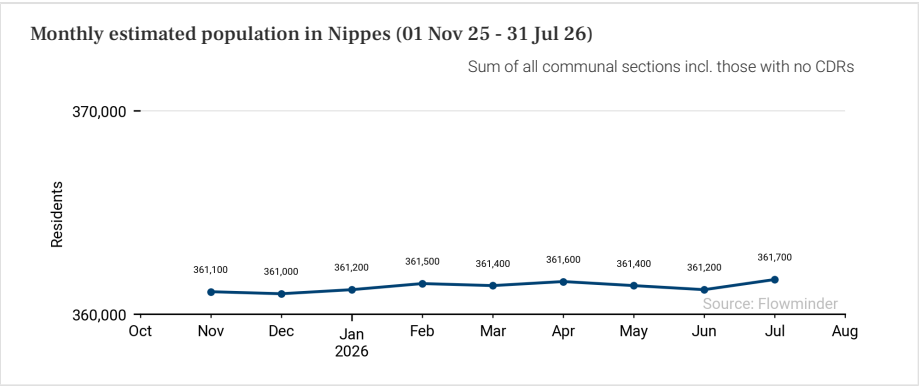
Largest month-to-month changes in resident population in fluctuating communal sections in Grande'Anse -department (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)



Cumulative estimated population change per communal section in Grande'Anse from 1 Nov 2025 to 31 Jul 2026



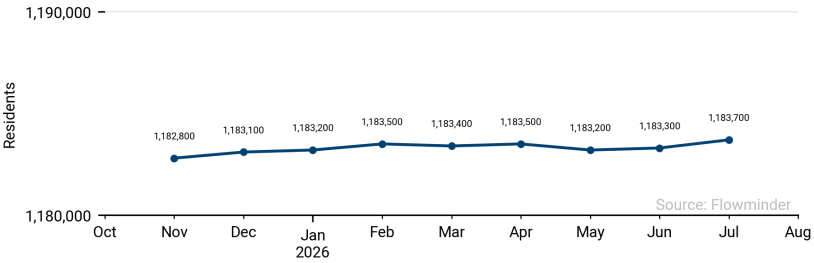

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Monthly estimated population in North (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

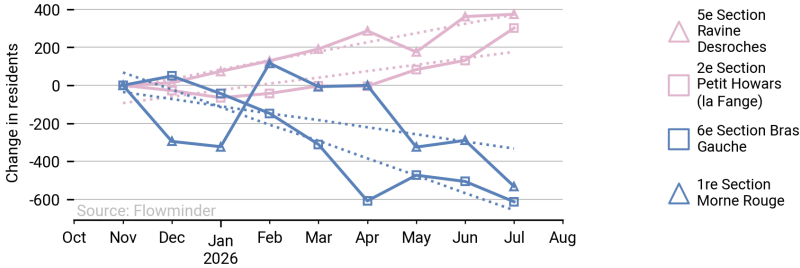

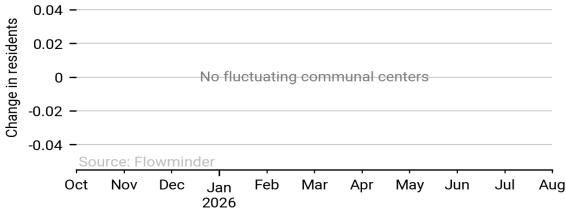
Communal sections in North with largest estimated change in population (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

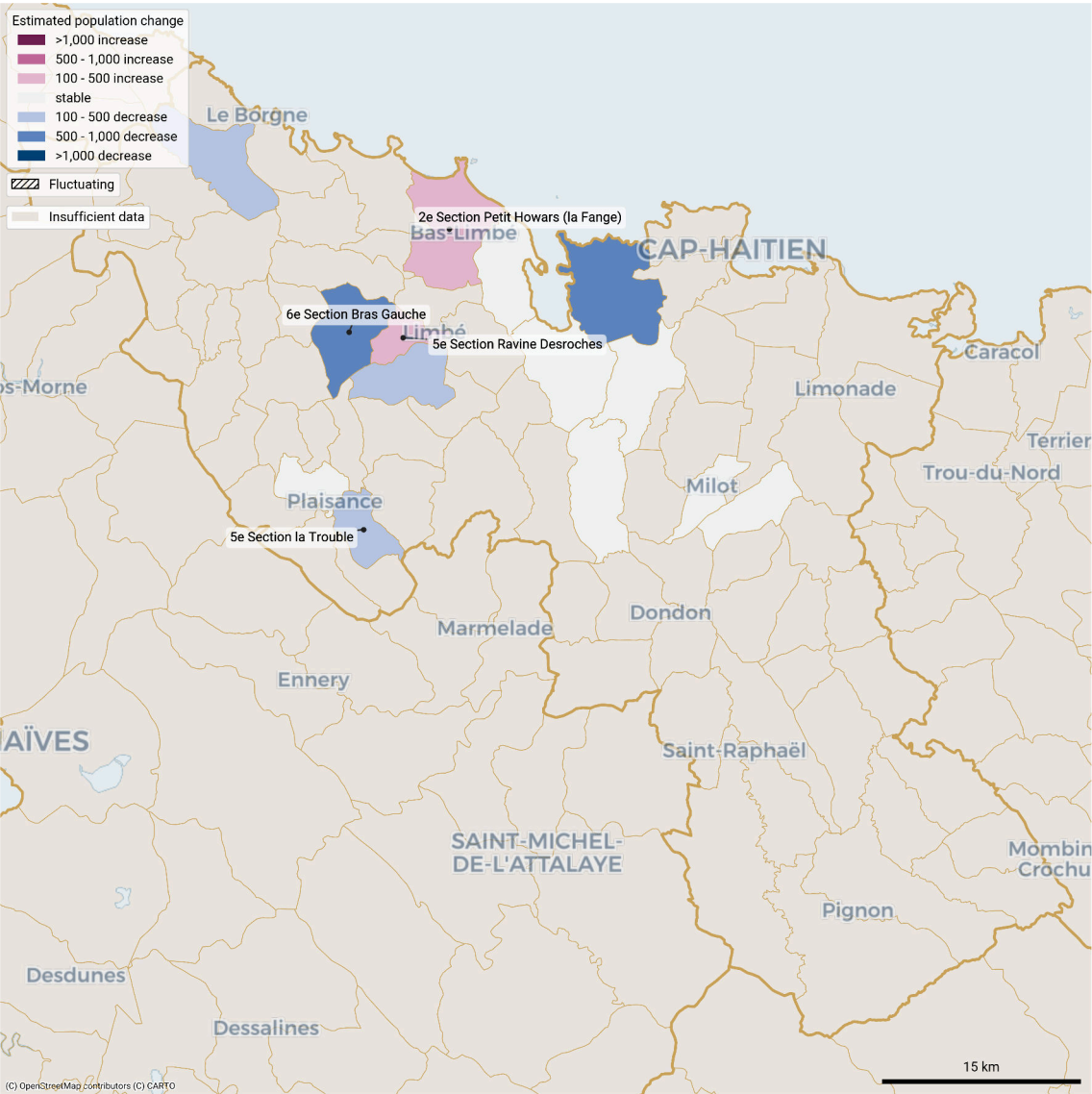

Largest month-to-month changes in resident population in fluctuating communal sections in North -department (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

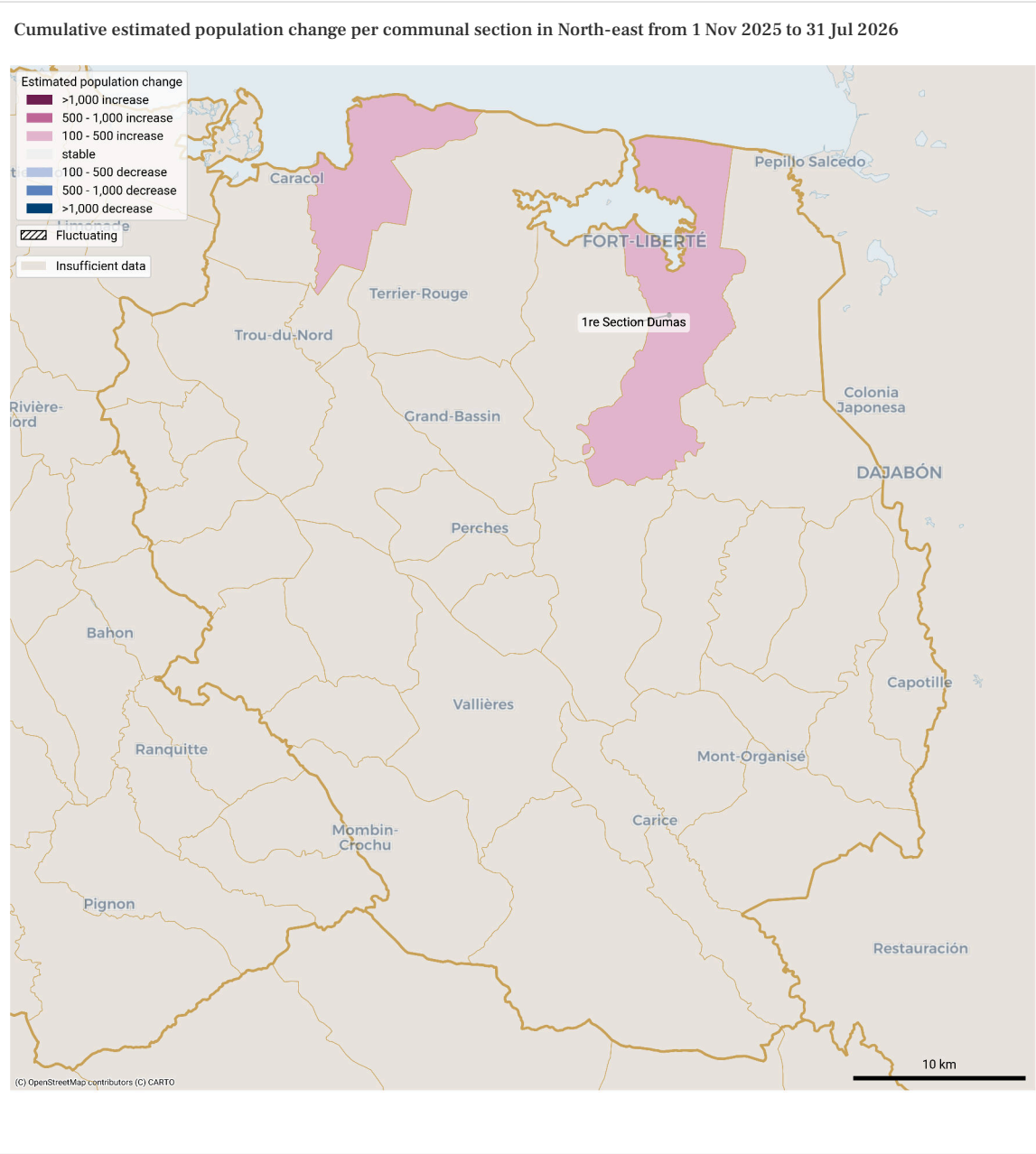
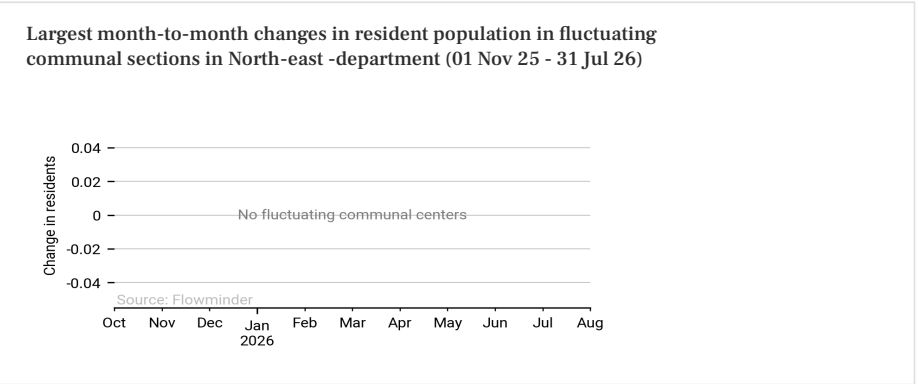
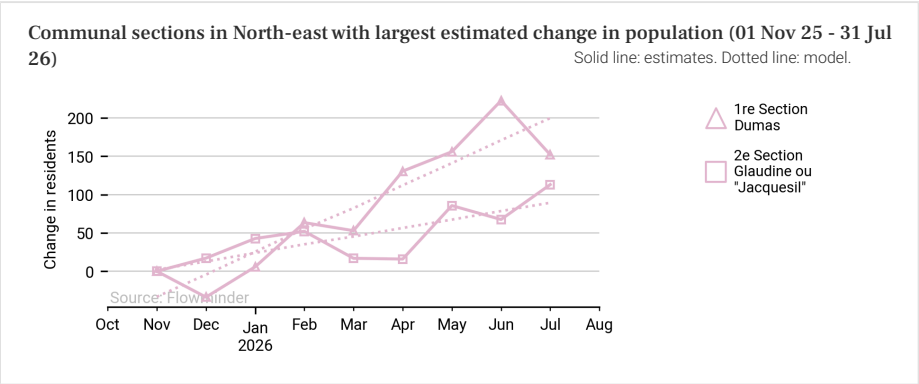
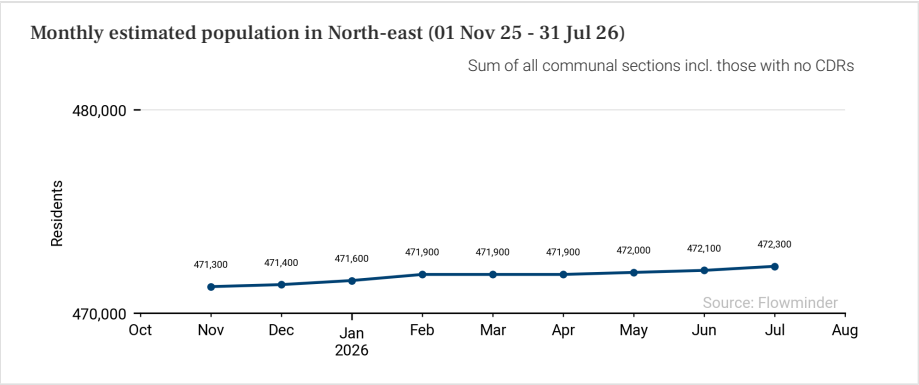

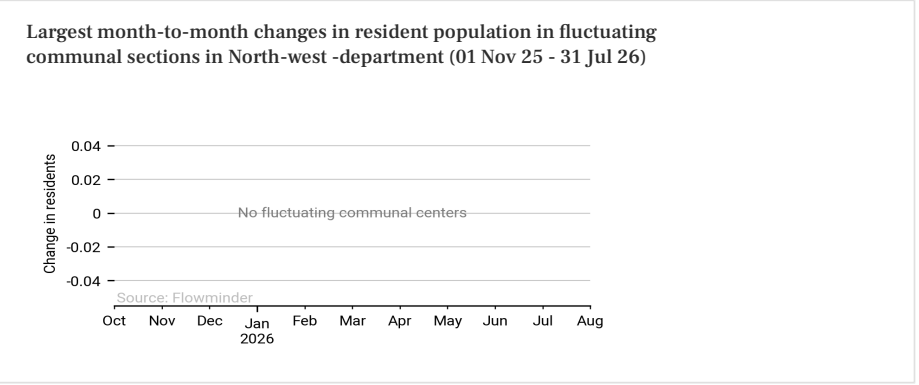
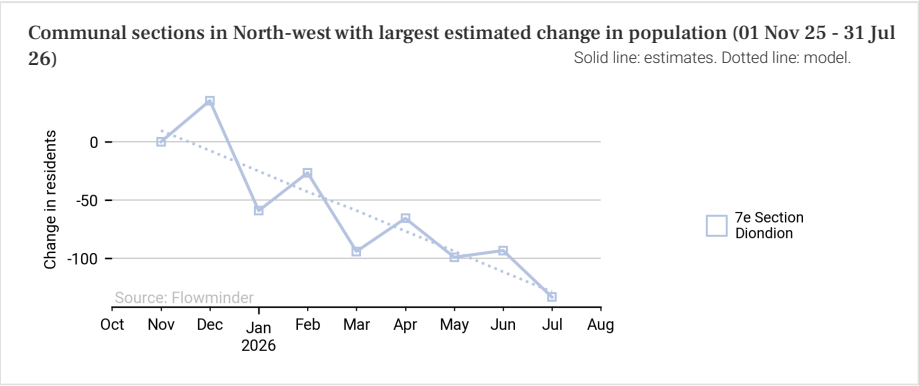
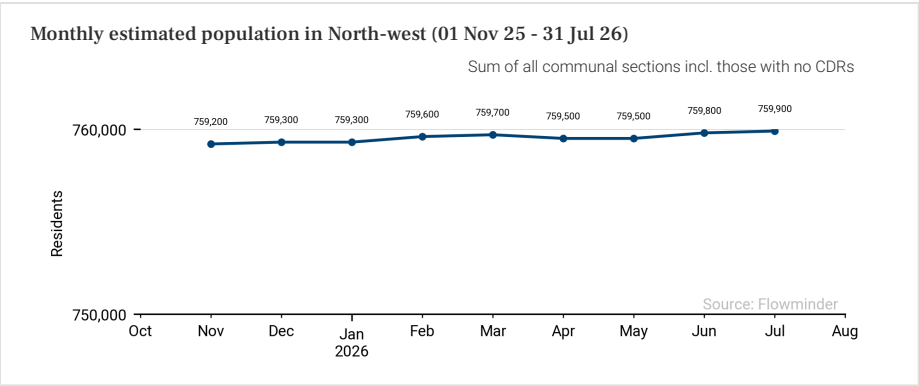
Cumulative estimated population change per communal section in North from 1 Nov 2025 to 31 Jul 2026



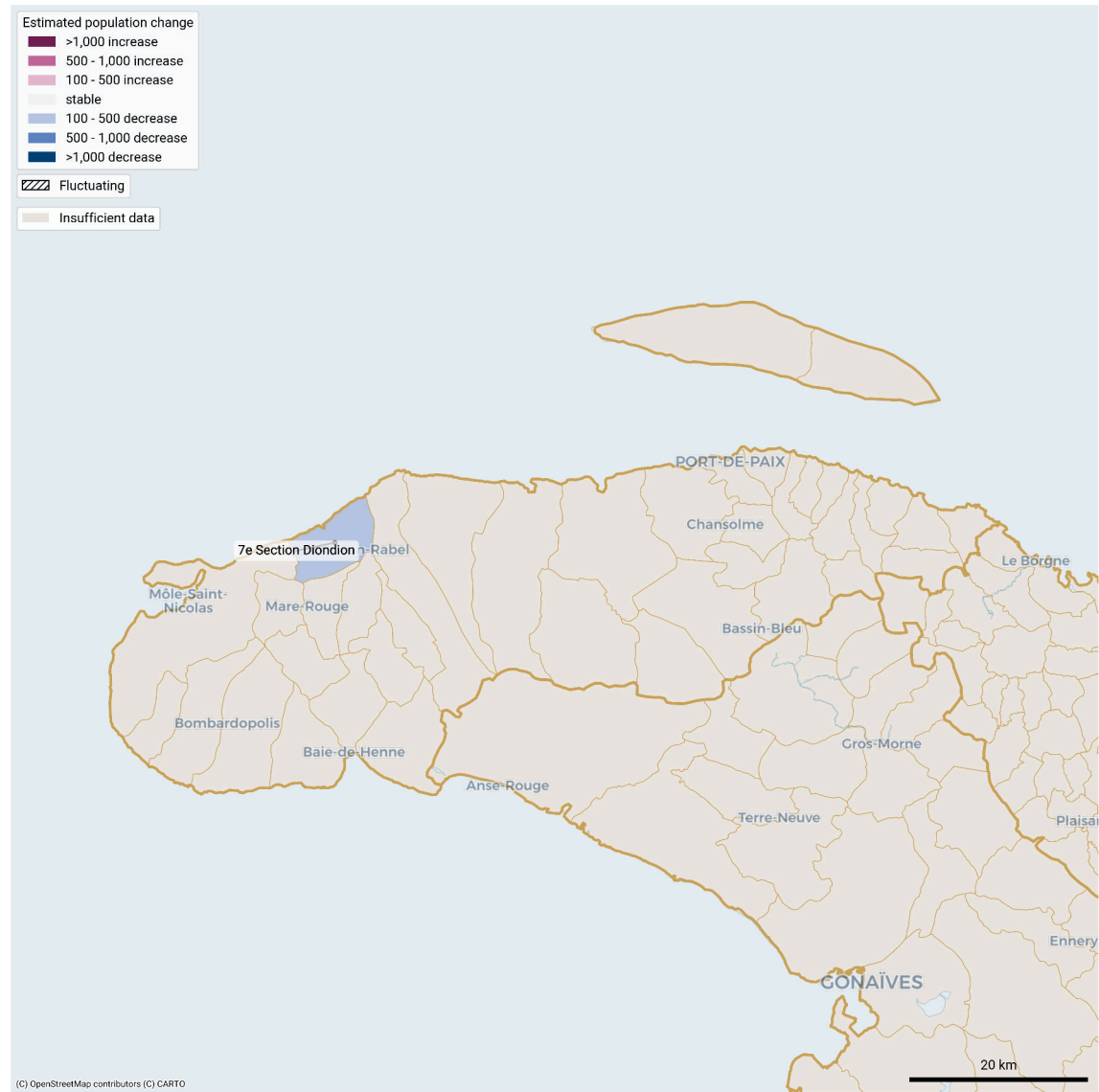
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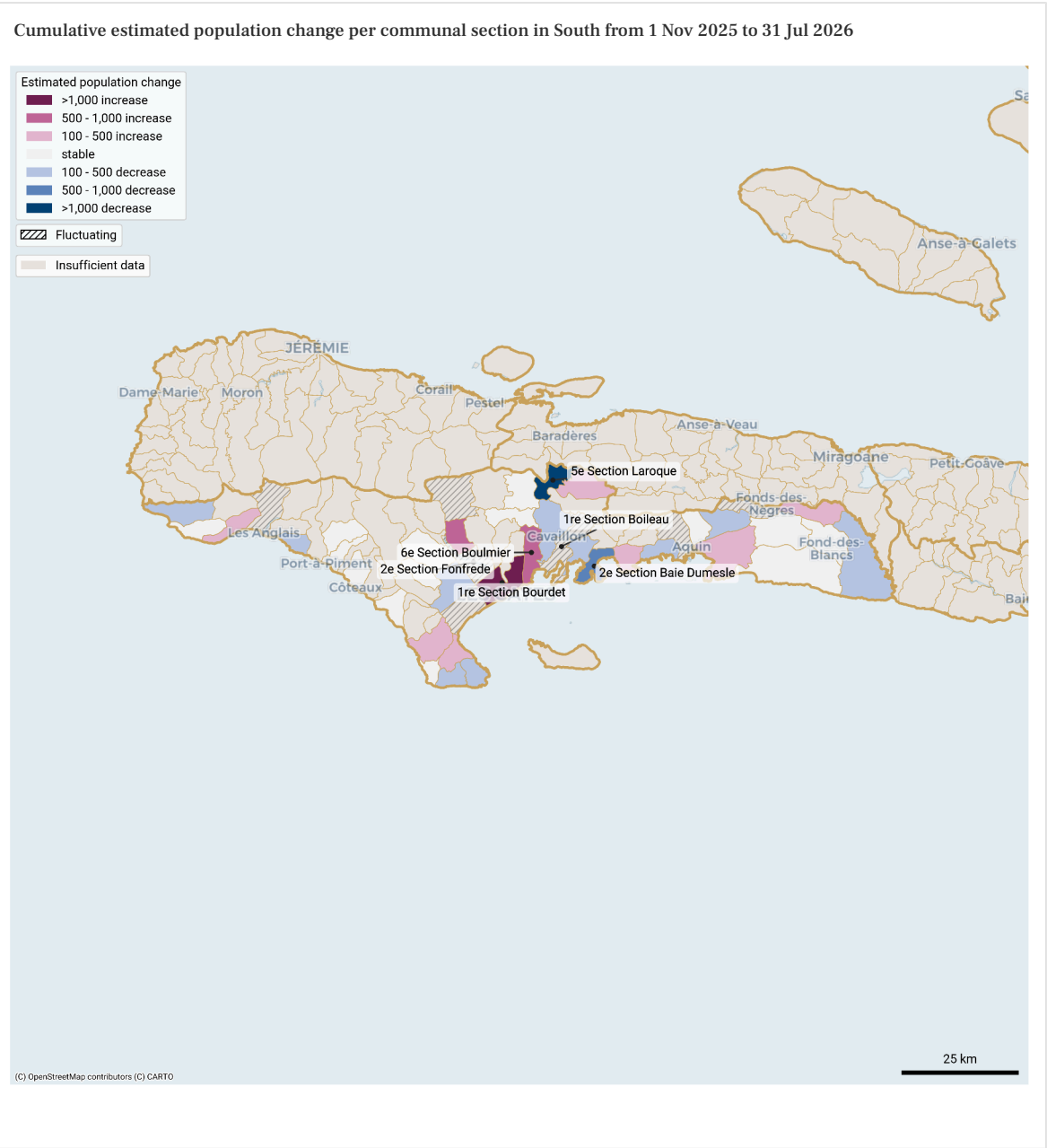
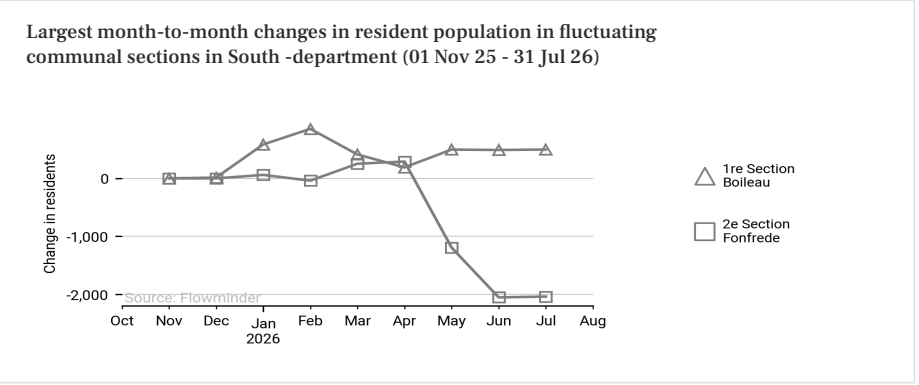
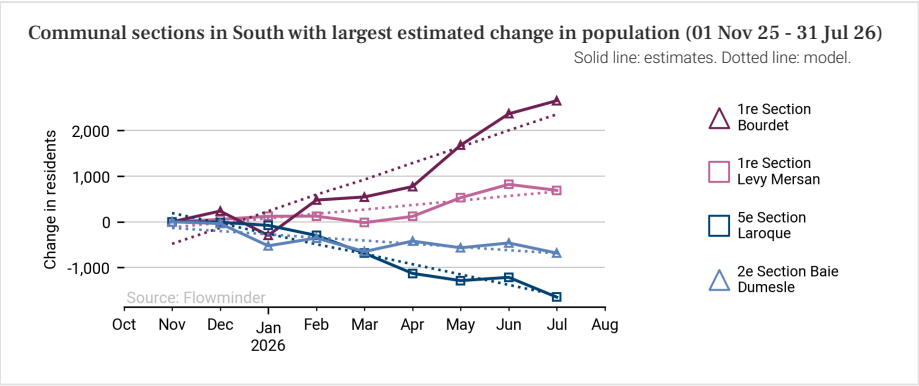
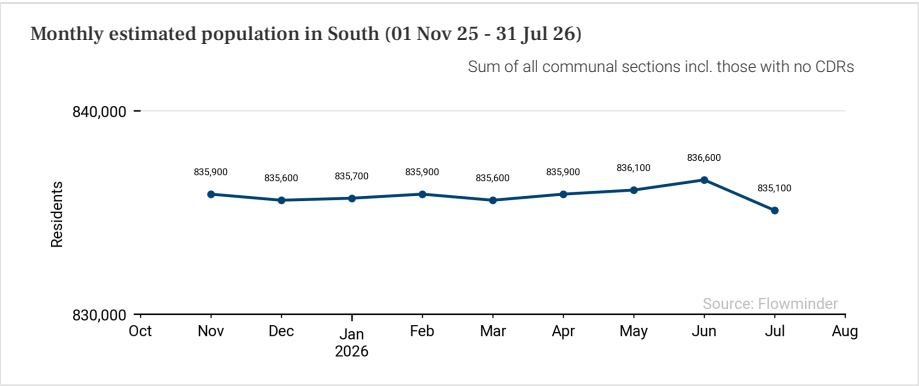
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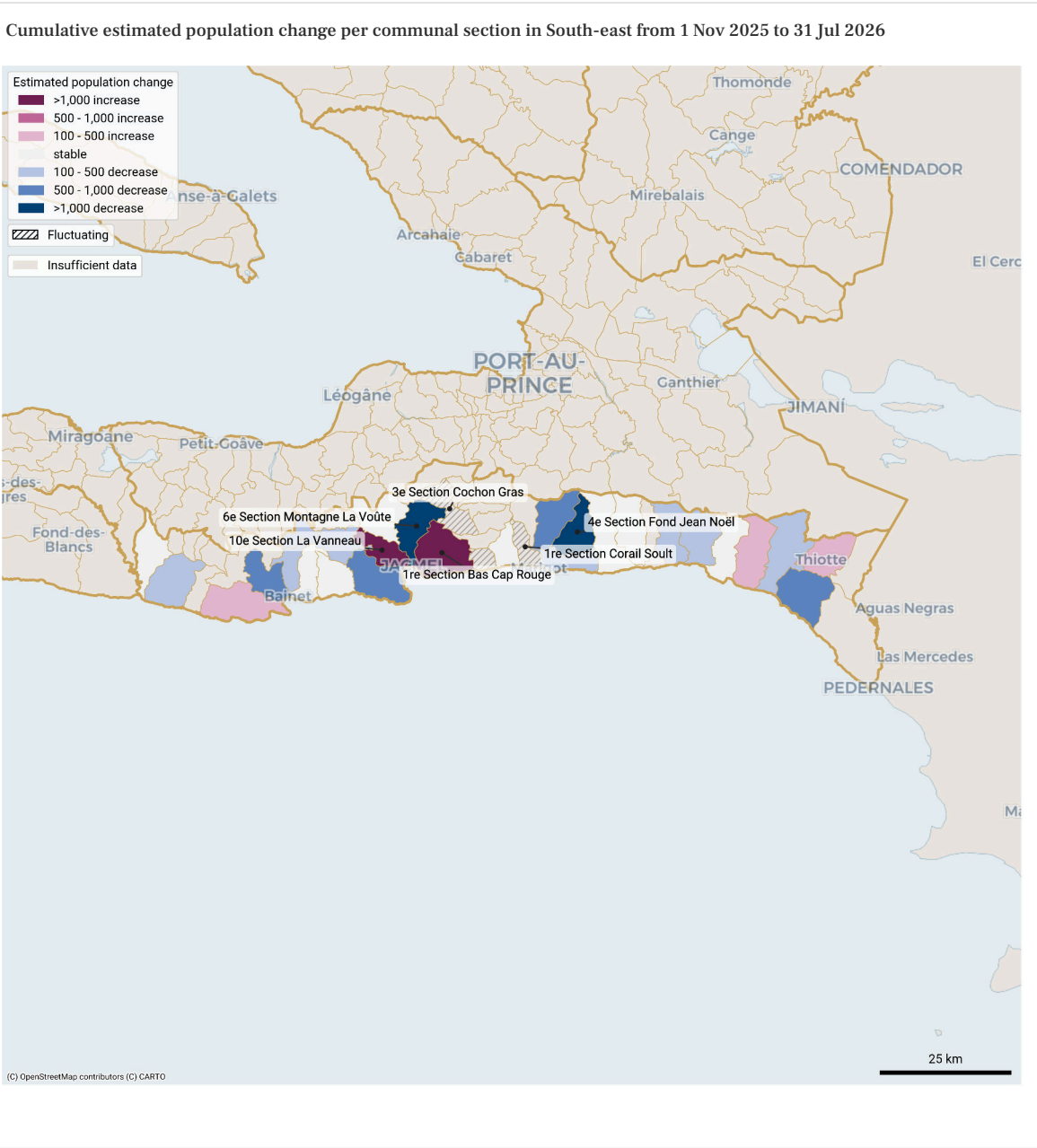
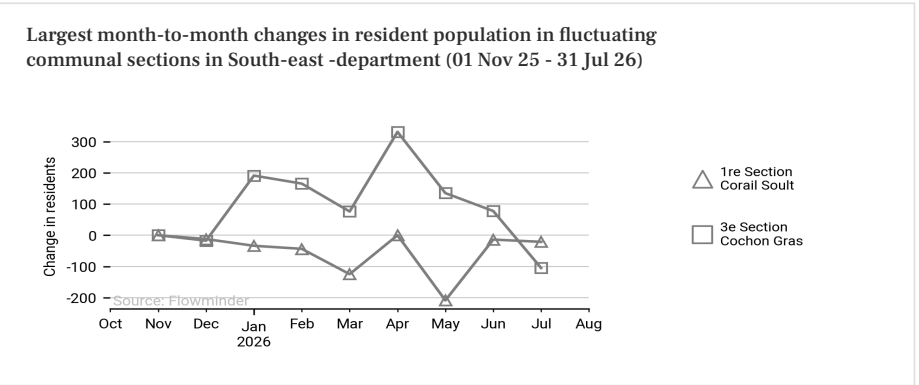
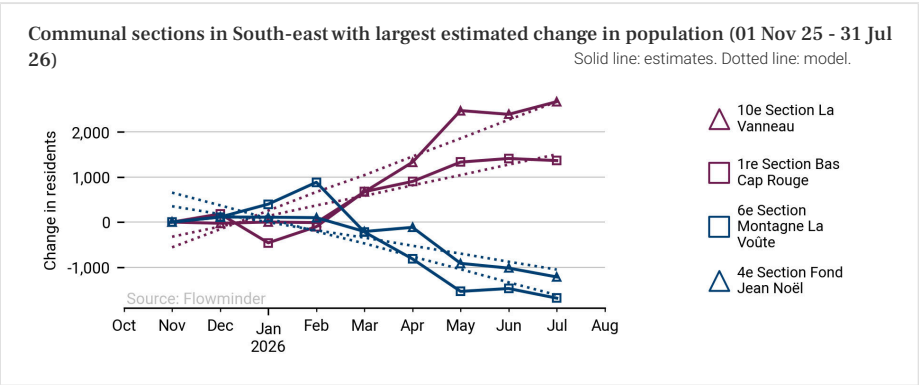
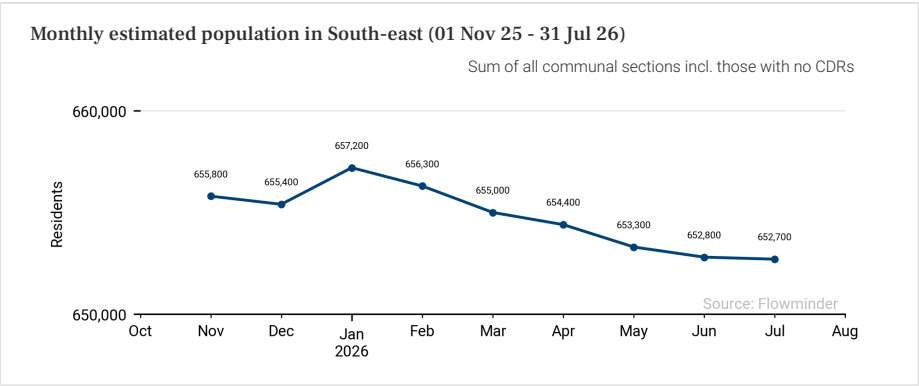
Cumulative estimated population change per communal section in North-west from 1 Nov 2025 to 31 Jul 2026



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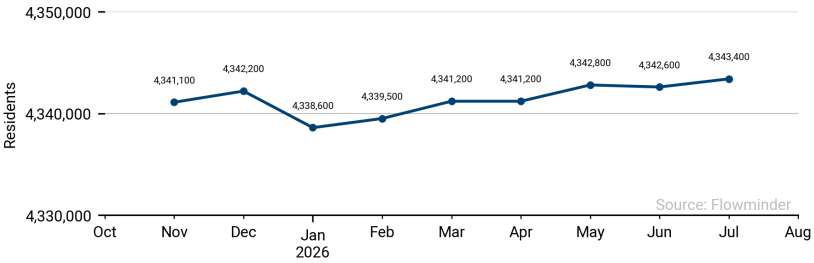
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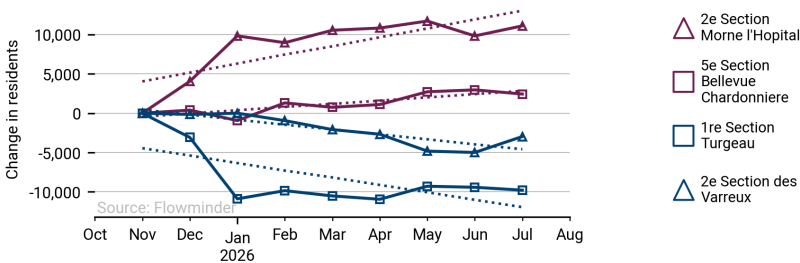
Monthly estimated population in West (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

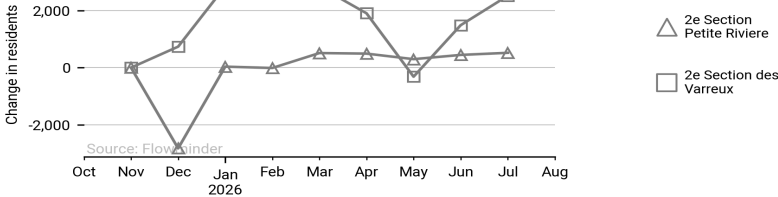


Communal sections in West with largest estimated change in population (01 Nov 25 - 31 Jul 26)

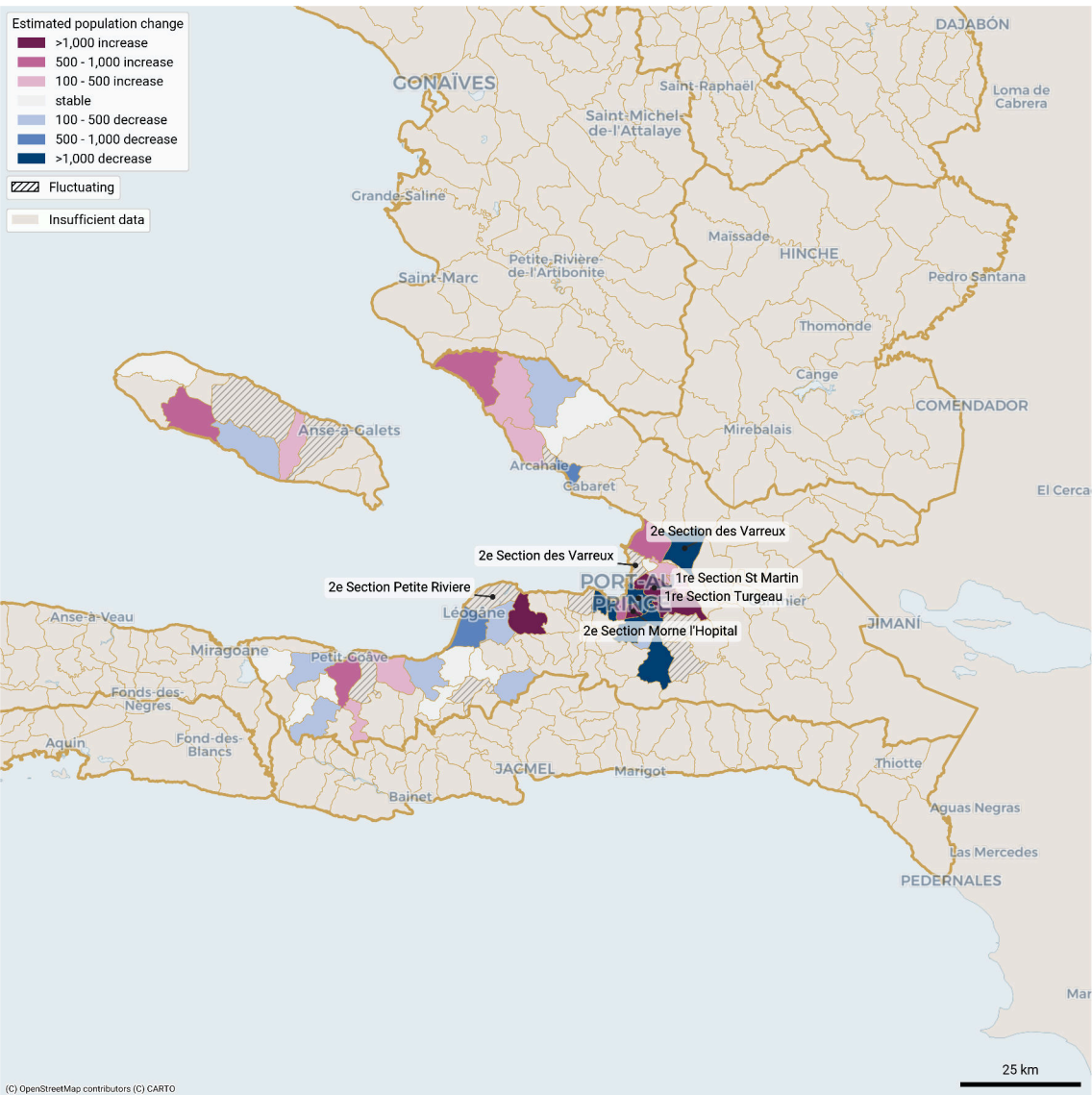

This study was made possible thanks to the anonymised (aggregated) Call Detail Records provided by a mobile network operator in Haiti.

How to use this report

We provide population estimates that take into account population movements within Haiti, per month and per communal section. We report the average decreasing/increasing trends for each communal section for which we have data. However, it is important to note that multiple trends can be observed over the reported 12-month period. The current crisis has led to large population movements, particularly of internally displaced people (e.g. [IDM round 5](#)), which can result in population statistics becoming outdated over a few months, and therefore impairing preparedness efforts (e.g. hazard population exposure estimation, needs assessment, service and contingency planning).

Indicators presented

Modelled change (trend): the predicted population change for the reporting period from all 12 monthly estimates, which smoothes out monthly variations (linear regression).

Estimated change: the difference in the estimated population between the first and last months of the 12 month reporting period, which does not reflect any monthly variation within.

For communal sections with fewer than 10 months of resident estimates during the reporting period, we do not make a trend classification (insufficient data). For monthly population estimates at the department level, we carry forward the latest estimate to fill missing months in a communal section so that the aggregated changes at the department level are only based on observed CDR-derived mobility.

For communal sections with fast changing populations, we categorised them as 'increasing', 'decreasing', 'stable', when there is little to no change, or as 'fluctuating' when large month-to-month changes prevented us from detecting a trend.

Data privacy & governance

No personal data, such as an individual's identity, demographics, location, contacts or movements, is made available to the government or any other third party at any time. All results produced by Flowminder are aggregated results (for example, subscriber density in a given municipality), which means that they do not contain any information about individual subscribers.

This data is fully anonymised. This approach complies with the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (EU GDPR2016/679). Data is processed on a server installed behind the mobile network operator's firewall in Haiti, and no personal data leaves the operator's premises.

Data considerations

The estimates shown are our best current assessment of movements. However, there are a number of uncertainties. The information should be interpreted together with other available evidence.
